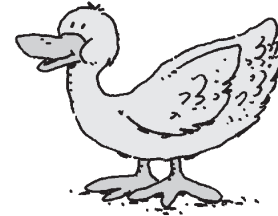
Speak Up for Animals

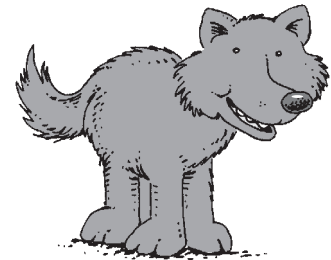
