

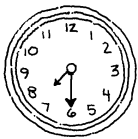
Right on Time

Tim has a cat named Sam. He has a dog named Harry. Here is their schedule. Look at each clock and circle the correct time.



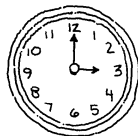
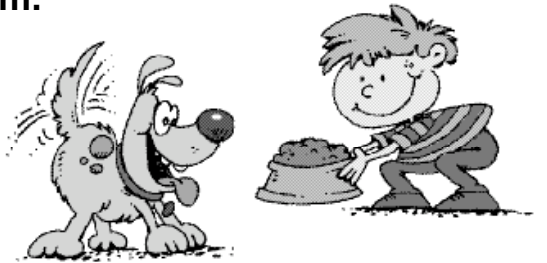
Tim feeds Sam and Harry at **6:00 a.m.**

6:15 p.m.



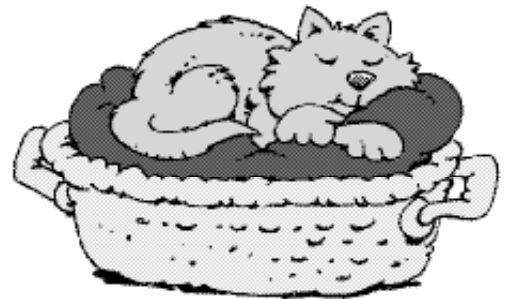
Tim gives Sam and Harry their dinner at **6:00 p.m.**
